About: Brown, Son & Ferguson The Company was established around 1850 as a retail stationery business, with initial premises on the south side of the River Clyde in Glasgow. In those early days the business was near the sailing ships which, at that time, navigated right up the Clyde into the heart of the City, so that it was little problem for the captains and crews of vessels to visit the book shop. These visits led the firm into the publishing of works connected with shipping. In 1876 came the first issue of Brown's Nautical Almanac - a valuable guide; it is still published annually today, and is commonly known as 'The Sailor's Bible'. The Company also publishes historical books. There is a large selection of 'Lubbock' titles which relates to the old sailing ships of many years ago.
